

Speaking Skills Assignment - Let's Learn and Share!

Dear students,

We are going to start a fun and exciting project to help you practice your **speaking skills**! This assignment will help you become more confident when speaking in front of others and teach you how to work together as a team.

Your speaking skills will be evaluated in **two ways**:

Part 1: Group Research and Poster

- You will work in **groups of four**.
- Each group will be given a **special topic** to research. Check the list of topics to know the topic of your group.
- a. **Tasks to be done at home**
 - At home, **each student will be responsible for one part** of the topic.
 - Find **interesting information** and bring **pictures** or drawings to support your part. You can print them, cut them out of magazines or draw them yourself!
 - Bring your materials to class.
- b. **Tasks to be done in the classroom**
 - Together with your group, you will:
 - **Create a colorful poster** using cardboard. Glue the pictures and write or glue the information in a neat and creative way.
 - **Practice your presentation** as a group.

Part 2: Presentation and Individual Speaking Evaluation

- **Present your project** to the class. Each student must speak about the part they researched.

 **Remember:** Be respectful listeners when other groups are presenting!

- During the group's presentation, **each student will be graded** on:
 - How clearly he/she speaks.
 - How well he/she explains your part of the topic.
 - How confident and enthusiastic he/she is.
 - How he/she answers simple questions from classmates or the teacher.

What You Need to Do:

- Research your part of the topic at home.
- Bring pictures and information to class.
- Work with your group to create your poster.
- Practice your speaking part.
- Present with your group on the day of the presentation.

Tips for a Great Presentation:

- Speak loudly and clearly.
- Look at your audience when you speak.
- Smile and show interest in your topic.
- Practice at home in front of your family!
