

Students will be assessed in writing a non-chronological report.

Use the notes below to help you prepare for the assessment.

1. You need to revise the features of a non-chronological report
Booklet (1) p. (88) + Booklet (2) pp. (1-5).
2. You need to read the model writing example that you can find attached and the reports that you wrote about ants and dogs.
Make sure to read your teacher's comments.
3. Kindly find attached a mind map that you can use to write a non-chronological report for more practice.

Note: In the assessment, students will be provided with a mind map that will include information about the topic to guide them in writing. They have to take the pieces of information from the mind map and to add their own ideas. The report should include different types of sentences- simple, compound and complex sentences. Also, they have to add connectives to connect the ideas together.
