2-Fill in the following blanks using the simple future with "going to":

1. I **am going to meet** him tomorrow. (not / meet)
2. Laith is starting university tomorrow. What **is** he **going to study** (study)?
3. Winter holidays **are going to be** in the first week of February. (be)
4. Tom **is going to help** you in your homework as he promised you. (help)

3-Fill in the following blanks using the simple future with will or going to:

1. A: Where are you going? Are you going shopping?
B: Yes, I **am going to buy** something for dinner. (I/buy)
2. A: I don't know how to use this camera.
B: It's easy. I **will show** you. (I/show)
3. A: What would you like to eat?
B: I **will have** sandwich, please. (I/ have)

4. A: Did you post the letter for me?
B: Oh, I'm sorry. I completely forgot. I **will do** it now. (I/do)

5. A: The ceiling in this room does not look very safe, does it?
B: No, it looks as if it **is going to fall** down. (it /fall)
