Fairy Tale / Traditional Tale / Folk Tale	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. indistinct time and place 2. animals behaving like humans (talking animals) 3. characters playing tricks 4. small brave characters 5. a moral 6. good triumphing over evil 7. It has a happy ending 8. It has magic
Adventurous Story	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) characters (often children) face situations that need quick thinking 2) a build-up to give hints and clues about what will happen 3) obstacles to get over 4) a resolution where the dilemma is solved 5) exciting plot 6) a hero or a heroine 7) short, snappy sentences for effect
