- Remember that a noun is a word that names a person, place or thing.
- Some nouns name one person, one place, or one thing.
- This kind of noun is called a singular noun.
Examples: doctor, mall, farm, bird, sister
- Some nouns name more than one person, one place, or one thing.
- This kind of noun is called a plural noun.
- Add -s to most singular nouns to make them plural.

Examples: one bug → two bugs
a duck → many ducks



- Some plural nouns do not end with **-s**. We change the whole word.


Singular Nouns	Plural Nouns

foot	feet

- Some nouns stay the same in the singular and plural forms.

Examples: one deer → two deer
 a sheep → some sheep





