Grammar Worksheet 2-Singular and Plural Nouns


- Remember a noun is a word that names a person, place or thing.
- Some nouns name **one person, place, or thing**. This kind of noun is called a **singular noun**.
Ex. doctor, mall, farm, bird, sister
- Some nouns name **more than one person, place, or thing**. This kind of noun is called a **plural noun**.
- Add **-s** to most singular nouns to make them plural.
Ex. one bug → two bugs
- Some plural nouns do not end with **-s**, we change the whole word.




Singular Nouns	Plural Nouns
child	children
man	men
mouse	mice
tooth	teeth
foot	feet

- Some nouns stay the same in the singular and plural forms.
Ex: one deer - two deer
one sheep - three sheep




