

Students are requested to study the following:

### **A. Comprehension:**

Students are expected to answer comprehension questions to an unseen text (fiction or non-fiction).

You can refer back to all the comprehension passages in booklet 1 (pp. 93- 132) and booklet 2 (pp. 34-72).

For more practice, answer Comprehension practice (6) pp.51-54 and Comprehension practice (8) pp.59-62 in booklet (2).

You are expected to study the following:

1. Booklet (1): figurative language (1) and (2) pp.4-7 and pp.51-54

- Identify the six types of figurative language in sentences.
- Find examples of figurative language in a text.

2. Booklet (1): Features of different genres: pp. 86-89

- Identify the features of fantasy fiction, newspaper report, non-chronological report and explanation text.
