

Our little grade 1 Mathematicians,

Let's celebrate your parent's age with this fun Math activity that relates numbers to real life context.

Follow these instructions to complete the activity.

<b>Step 1</b>	On your notebook, <b>write</b> the <b>date</b> and the <b>title</b> " <b>My Parent Age</b> "
<b>Step 2</b>	<b>Cut</b> the cake picture provided and stick it to your notebook.
<b>Step 3</b>	<b>Ask</b> your parent: How old are you?
<b>Step 4</b>	Is there something missing on the cake?! Yes we have to put the candles but this time as tens and ones blocks. <b>Cut, color and stick</b> them on the top of the cake, don't forget to <b>draw the flame</b> on each tens and ones blocks. <i>Example: if your parent's age is 36 years old you need to stick 3 tens and 6 ones blocks.</i>
<b>Step 5</b>	<b>Color</b> the cake with your favorite colors, and write a message" Happy Birthday!"
<b>Step 6</b>	<b>Draw</b> on the same page <b>a place value chart</b> and write the age as tens and ones, in numerals and in words.
