Count on and show your partner.




11 kites



Let's Learn

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a 6 rabbits are eating and 2 rabbits are sleeping.
How many rabbits are there altogether?



Count on from 6 to add.

6, 7, 8


There are 8 rabbits altogether.

What do you notice when you count on?

When we count on, the number gets larger.



b There are 3 lemons and 6 pears.

How many fruit are there altogether?

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You can use a number line to count on.




Count on from 6.



There are 9 fruit altogether.

Count on from 3 is the same as count on from 6! It is quicker to count on from the larger number.

5, 6, 7, 8, 9




There are 9 frogs altogether.
