Izzy has 2 ^{groups} plates of 4 ^{items} oranges.

How many oranges does she have altogether?

Write a multiplication sentence to show.

number of groups \times number of items = product

$$2 \times 4 = 8$$

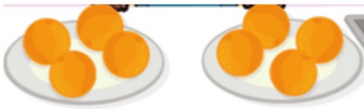
2 plates \times 4 oranges = 8 oranges altogether



Thinking Cap



Ralph puts 8 oranges equally on 2 plates.
Write a division sentence to show.
What can you say about the division
sentence and the multiplication sentence?



$$8 \div 2 = 4 \text{ oranges in each plate}$$
