Ravi bought 4 kites, 2 pencil cases and 3 footballs.

How much did she spend in all?

$$\text{kites } 4 \times 2 = \$8$$

$$8 + 6 + 12 =$$

$$\text{pencils } 2 \times 3 = \$6$$

$$8 + 6 = 14$$

$$\text{football } 3 \times 4 = \$12$$

$$14 + 12 = 26 \quad \$ \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \quad 26$$

$$8 + 6 + 12 = \$26$$

Q2. There are 18 apples in a bag.

How many apples are there in 5 bags? Show your work.

$$5 \times 18 = 90$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 10 \\ \times 5 \\ \hline 50 \end{array}$$

$$8 \times 5 = 40$$

$$50 + 40 = 90$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 18 \\ \times 5 \\ \hline 90 \end{array}$$

90 apples

Q3. Roy bakes 23 cupcakes a day.

- How many cupcakes does he bake in 3 days?

$$\begin{array}{r} 23 \\ \times 3 \\ \hline 69 \end{array}$$

$3 \times 23 =$
 $20 \ 3$

$$20 \times 3 = 60$$

$$3 \times 3 = 9$$

$$60 + 9 = 69$$

69 cupcakes

Q4. Tom went to the store and bought a number of chairs.

Each chair costs 52 dollars.

How much money did Tom pay for the 4 chairs he bought?

$$\begin{array}{r} 4 \times 52 = 208 \\ 50 \ 2 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 52 \\ \times 4 \\ \hline 208 \end{array}$$

$$50 \times 4 = 200$$

$$2 \times 4 = 8$$

$$200 + 8 = 208$$

208 dollars
