

Divide as Sharing Equally



1 Jack puts 16 muffins into 2 boxes equally.
How many muffins are there in each box?



If you are not sure, you can refer to Student's Book pages 124 to 126.



$$16 \div 2 = \underline{\quad 8 \quad}$$

There are 8 muffins in each box.

2 Nisa gives 20 cookies to 4 friends equally.
How many cookies does each friend get?



$$20 \div 4 = \underline{\quad 5 \quad}$$

Each friend gets 5 cookies.



3 Share the pieces of cheese equally among the mice.

How many pieces of cheese will each mouse get?

Draw 1 in each group each time.

$$\underline{10} \quad \div \quad \underline{5} \quad = \quad \underline{2}$$

Each mouse gets 2 pieces of cheese.

b



$$\underline{12} \quad \div \quad \underline{2} \quad = \quad \underline{6}$$

Each mouse gets 6 pieces of cheese.
