Let's Learn

a There are 7 rabbits. 3 of them hop away.

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How many rabbits are left?



Count back from 7.

4, 5, 6, 7


4 rabbits are left.

I can count back to subtract. When you count back, the numbers get smaller.



b Subtract 2 from 15.


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- is called minus. It means subtract. $15 - 2 = 13$ is a subtraction sentence.



You can use a number line to count back.



What is 2 more than 13?

How many frogs are left?


5, 6, 7, 8, 9

2 Subtract.


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Use a number line to help you.



a $18 - 2 =$ 16

b $17 - 3 =$ 14






3 Caz says $9 + 3$ is the same as $14 - 3$.

Ron says $9 + 2$ is the same as $13 - 2$.

Who do you agree with? **I agree with Ron.**

Tell your classmate why you think so.

Use a number line.



Caz is incorrect because $9 + 3 = 12$ and $14 - 3 = 11$.

12 and 11 are not the same.

Ron is correct because $9 + 2 = 11$ and $13 - 2 = 11$.

Both equals to 11 hence $9 + 2 = 13 - 2$.
