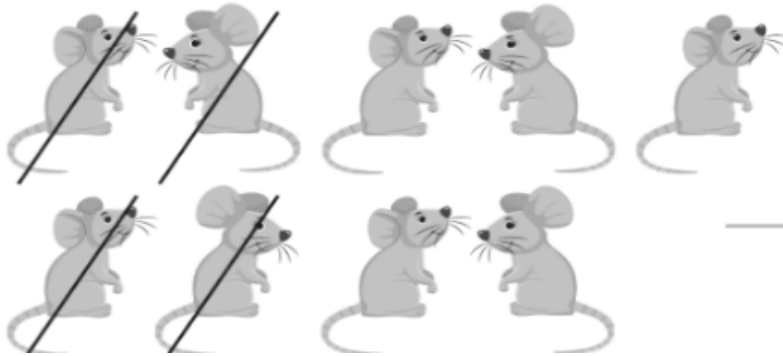

 lemons are left.

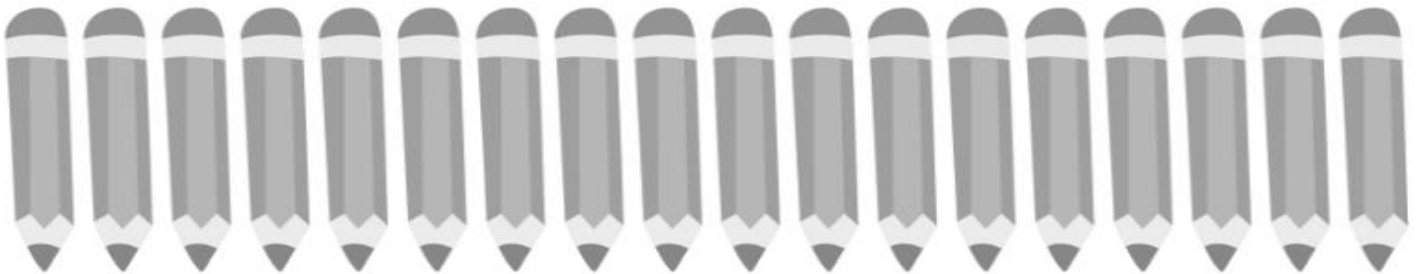
- 3 There are 15 boxes.

How many boxes are left?



$$\underline{15} - \underline{6} = \underline{9}$$

9 boxes are left.

- 4 Raiz has 18 coloured pencils.  
Ming borrows 3 of his coloured pencils.  
How many coloured pencils does Raiz have left?



$$\underline{18} - \underline{3} = \underline{15}$$

Raiz has 15 coloured pencils left.

- 5 Kelly has some red and green apples.  
There are between 12 and 15 apples in total.  
3 of the apples are red and the rest are green.  
How many green apples are there if Kelly has the least number of apples?

$$13 - 3 = 10$$

There are 10 green apples.
