## Subtract by Finding Difference

What You Will Learn:


- Subtract by finding the difference between two numbers.

### Look Back

Ron buys 17 papayas.

He gives 3 away.

$$17 - 3 = 14$$



Do not give up trying!

How many papayas does Ron have left?

14 papayas



### Thinking Cap



Izzy has 6 papayas.

How many more papayas does Ron have than Izzy?

Use unit cubes to show how you work out the answer.



Ron has 8 more papayas than Izzy.

## Let's Learn


a Caz picks 6 seashells.  
Ron picks 2 seashells.



Finding the difference is the same as finding how many more or how many fewer.



What is the difference between the number of seashells Caz and Ron pick?



You need to add 4 more seashells to make 6 seashells.




Caz picks 4 more seashells than Ron.

Ron picks 4 fewer seashells than Caz.

The difference is 4 seashells.


b Find the difference between 5 and 8.



We need to count on from 5 to 8.

The difference is 3.

We can also count back from 8 to 5 to find the difference.



The difference is 3.

a What is the difference between the number of apples on the 1st plate and the 2nd plate?  $8 - 6 = 2$

b What is the difference between the number of apples on the 2nd plate and the 3rd plate?  $6 - 4 = 2$

c What can you say about the differences?

d How many apples will there be on the 5th plate? zero

3 Eddy and Izzy have 11 crayons.

Eddy has 1 more crayon than Izzy.

How many crayons does each child have?

Eddy has 6 crayons and Izzy has 5.
