


Look Back

Caz has $\frac{1}{2}$ of an egg tart.

Eddy has $\frac{2}{4}$ of a similar egg tart.



Caz says she has the same size of egg tart as Eddy.

Is she correct? How do you know?

yes

$$\frac{2}{4} \text{ is equal to } \frac{1}{2}$$

we multiply the numerator and denominator by the same number.

$$\frac{1 \times 2}{2 \times 2} = \frac{2}{4}$$

they are equivalent fractions

Equivalent fractions are parts of the same whole.

They have different numerators and denominators but are equal in value.
