

**Verb (to have)** :We use (has) to tell about one and (have) to tell about more than one in the present simple tense. (I) is an exception  
Examples: The book **has** thirty pages.

The boys **have** nice bikes.

I **have** to go to the doctor.

Pronouns	Verb to have
I, you, they, we	<b>have</b>
he, she, it	<b>has</b>
