


## Look Back

What fraction of the apple pie is left?

2 out of 4 parts of the apple pie is left.

2 of the apple pie is left.

$$\frac{3}{4} - \frac{1}{4} = \frac{2}{4}$$

Izzy had  $\frac{3}{5}$  of an apple pie. She ate  $\frac{1}{5}$  of it.

What fraction of the apple pie does she have left?

How do you know? Use fraction bars to help you.
