This year, we have got a few changes you need to be aware of in how you engage with your studies and a few new aspects.

Dear Parents,

Kindly be informed that:

- LMS is the official communication way where all the Instructions, Assignments, materials and scheduled assessments are posted.
- Parents can communicate with teachers through **LMS Teachers/Chat**.
- Students will sit for a diagnostic test to evaluate their knowledge to help determine their weaknesses if any and work on it before the official Checkpoint assessment.

- **Grade 6 students will sit for a checkpoint exam in October. (We will inform you of the date of the exam later on.)**
- All the required skills, Comprehension, Writing, Speaking and Listening in addition to Novel will be covered throughout the year.

Checkpoint Exam:- Students are expected to practice the topics posted on 5th grade Google Classroom .They should use worksheets, study sheets, classwork copybooks and their books as their reference while studying in addition to the material that will be covered in 6th grade. (Details related to the checkpoint exam will be discussed with students in class and then posted on **LMS**).

Comprehension skills:

- Checkpoint past papers will be practiced and discussed in the classroom.
- Checkpoint assessments formative and summative will be conducted.
- Some papers for extra practice will be assigned for students to do at home, and markscheme will be posted later on to check their performance.

The past papers are assembled in a Comprehension Booklet handed to students in class.

Writing Skills:

- Writing topics related to the Checkpoint will be practiced in addition to new topics required in our curriculum.
- Checkpoint assessments formative and summative will be conducted.

Listening Skills:

- Students will be assessed at any time during the month. (summative assessments only)

Grammar:

- Students are required to revise all the tenses, punctuation marks, types of sentences as they are needed while writing.
- Formative and summative assessments will be done regularly after each topic.

Speaking Skills:

- Students will be asked to prepare their topics on the spot and present them in class.

- **2 books are handed to you:**

- 1) Lower Secondary English (main book)
- 2) Successful Writing Book

- **Novel:**
 - Students are expected to read the required chapters in the novel so they can understand the discussion held in class.
 - Chapters read will be discussed and analyzed in class as a practice of comprehension skills .
 - Students should expect to be evaluated in class to assess their reading and understanding.
 - 4 Novels are handed to you, 2 of them to be read and discussed in class and the other 2 are home readers.
- Class reader: Oliver Twist (1st Semester)
- Home reader: The Enemy (1st Semester) Students are expected to finish reading it by **November 20, 2025** Students are required to read a few chapters every month.
- Class reader: Jane Eyre (2nd Semester) Home reader: David Copperfield (2nd Semester) students are expected to finish reading by **May 11, 2026**. Students are required to read a few chapters every month.

MARKS:

- Summative assessments and quizzes
- Participation
- Homework assignments
- Classwork and Behaviors
- Bonus marks for extra or outstanding work.

Note: Good work and behavior will be rewarded, on the other hand missed assignments and ill behavior will be taken into consideration.

A message will be sent to the parents on LMS to inform them if the student has missed any required homework to keep you updated.
