Q1:

A: They help keep the tanks clean.

Q2: (Do not give/accept more than one answer).

(a): Spots: sees or notices.

(b): lure: tempt or attract or entice.

(c): tale: story.

(d): Supports: gives evidence for or reinforces or helps.

Q3:

“Do you think dolphins are clever enough to know what we are thinking ?” asked the spectator. The researcher smiled, “I don t know,” she said. “They are certainly intelligent, friendly, and playful”.

Q4: (Use a relative pronoun: Who, which, that)
