Q1: suspension → a liquid containing small pieces of an insoluble substances that sink slowly

Colloid → a liquid containing small pieces of an insoluble substances that do not sink

Mixture → two or more substances jumbled up together

Solution → a liquid containing dissolved substances

Q2: It contains substances other than water, such as mud, human waste and other solids.

Q3; a -solution : sea water, fizzy drink

Colloid: milk, StyrofoamTM, fog, paint

b- solution: coffee, tea, juice

colloid: mayonnaise, butter, jelly

suspension: sand/water mix, oil/water mix.
