

The number '40' has the greatest 10s.




Let's Learn

Izzy, Ralph and Caz have some crayons.

I have 24 crayons.

They draw a number line to compare the numbers.

smaller numbers



greater numbers

We are counting on in ones from 20 till 40.

24 is **smaller** than 38.

38 is **greater** than 24.

24 is closer to 20 than to 30.

38 is closer to 40 than to 30.



Show 28 on the number line.

28

is closer to 30 than to 20.


