Features/tasks	Tick

New paragraphs are used when there is a change of time, place, action or speaker.	
Interesting adjectives to describe nouns are used.	
Speech (what the characters said) is included.	
The senses are used to describe the house.	
Strong verbs are used, e.g. cried, kicked.	
Spelling is correct.
