

Answers vary. For example: semicircle, triangle.




This figure has 1 curved edge(s), 2 straight edge(s) and 1 vertex.


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b What shapes can you see in this figure?

Answers vary. For example: triangles, square.




This figure has 0 curved edge(s), 6 straight edge(s) and 6 vertices.



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
2 Shape B is made by combining 3 of Shape A. Draw dotted lines on Shape B to show each of Shape A.

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3 Combine the triangles to form a rectangle.




How many right angles does a rectangle have? 4

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4 Combine 4 of rectangle A to make a square




5 Combine 4 of triangle C to make a rectangle. Accept any correct answer.
