You will need:

a pumpkin



a candle



a knife



1 spoon



a blade



2. What to do:



1. First, slice off the top of the pumpkin carefully.




2. Next, scoop the seeds out of the pumpkin using a spoon.



3. Then, use a marker to trace the eyes, nose and mouth.



4. After that, use a blade to carve out the shapes.



5. Finally, light the candle and place it inside the pumpkin.

Be careful! The blade is too sharp!
